
We care about your personal data and are committed to ensuring its confidentiality and security.

Personal information we collect:

We refer to this automatically collected information as "Device Information". Why do we process your data?

Our top priority is the security of customer data and, as such, we can process only minimal user data, only to the extent absolutely necessary to maintain the website. Automatically collected information is used only to identify potential cases of abuse and to establish statistical information about the use of the website.

Your rights


You have the following rights related to your personal data:
